Terms & Conditions

Below are the Terms and Conditions on which we, Freddie Farmer Foundation, provide physiotherapy services. The exact Services we will provide to you will depend on what we agree following the result of your initial assessment

Costs of sessions and payment fees

Our fees for each session are as confirmed by us to you. You are personally liable to pay all of our fees and any surcharges incurred, such as any cancellation fees.

Cost of treatment for 2015/2016 will be £25 an hour.

Cost of treatment for 2017 will be £30 an hour

Please note, the last 10 minutes of your child's 3 hour or 2 hour daily session will be for the physiotherapist to write up their notes of the days' therapy.

A £100 deposit for each block session is payable to secure the session. This is non – refundable.

Full payment for block session(s) is payable 4 weeks prior to start of treatment.

Failure to pay invoices on time will result in the session being offered to another family.

Payment Methods

We are happy to accept payment for our Services in cash, cheque, debit/credit card or via bank transfer (our bank details will be included on your invoice). Cheques made payable to Freddie Farmer Physiotherapy Centre Ltd.

Cancellation of Sessions

As we have to carefully plan our diary to accommodate block sessions we require at least 4 weeks notice for intended cancellation.

Cancelled sessions due to medical grounds will be subject to a full refund on receipt of a medical letter, or the amount will be transferred to another booking if applicable.

Absences

Freddie Farmer Foundation reserves the right to cancel sessions of therapy if a physiotherapist is ill. Where possible we will endeavor to rearrange the missed sessions. If this is not possible, a refund will be issued or a credit applied to another booking.

If a whole block session has to be cancelled by us we will refund the whole amount or we will transfer the amount to another booking if applicable.

If you have to cancel a session with less than 24 hours' notice then you are liable to pay the cost of that session. If your child is absent due to illness for more than three days, Freddie Farmer Foundation will endeavor to rearrange the missed sessions or apply a credit to another booking on receipt of a doctors certificate.

In the case of vomiting bugs, we operate a 48 hour from last symptom policy. It is at the discretion of the therapist providing treatment as to whether they continue to do so if they feel a child is too unwell to continue.

Arriving Late for a session

Please note any time you arrive late for a session will not be added onto the end of that session. No refund will be made for late arrivals.

Adverse Weather Policy

In the event of adverse weather conditions, should the Centre remain fully operational a refund will not be issued for missed sessions. If the Centre has to close then a refund for missed sessions will be made or the refund transferred to another booking, if applicable.

Confidentiality

We shall treat all personal information supplied by you as confidential. We shall not disclose such information to any third party without your prior permission, except where required by law or where action might be necessary to protect you or someone else.

Responsibility/Liability

Parents must sign an agreement stating that they take full responsibility for their child and for any accidents that might occur when their child is not with a therapist having therapy.

If a child needs to use the bathroom during a session, the parent/guardian will take their child to the bathroom. All children must be accompanied to the toilet by a parent or guardian at all times.

Siblings who are present during sessions are the responsibility of parents whilst at our Centre. We ask that siblings refrain from running around our Centre as this can disrupt the therapy sessions. All siblings must remain in the family room with a parent or guardian at all times. On occasions where there may only be one therapist in the building providing therapy we ask that parents stay in the Centre to aid in an emergency situation.

Visitor records

All parents are required to sign in and out of the Centre using the visitor's book, leaving a contact number and car registration details. Families are welcome to leave the Centre but please make sure you can be contacted in an emergency.

All other occasional visitors such as teachers and other physiotherapists must make an appointment if they wish to visit the Freddie Farmer Physiotherapy Centre.

Agreements

This agreement is between the client and Freddie Farmer Foundation. Freddie Farmer Foundation may make amendments to the current Terms and Conditions without prior warning to the client. Terms and Conditions will be issued along with the first invoice and must be signed and returned prior to the session taking place.
